

## **PRESS RELEASE**

Between 24 April and 5 May, some 210,000 passengers will be travelling for the long, spring weekends of 25 April and 1 May

From 24 April to 5 May – during the two long, spring weekends of 25 April and 1 May - a total of some 210,000 passengers are expected to arrive and depart from Naples airport: 110,000 on domestic, 80,000 on international and 20,000 on charter flights.

The highest passenger flows are expected to take place **Monday**, **28 April and Saturday**, **3 May**, respectively, with some **18,000 and 20,000 passengers**.

Weekend of 1 May (30 April – 5 May)	110,000 passengers: 59,000 domestic, 41,000 international and 10,000 charter

Barcelona, London, Paris, Berlin, Madrid and Prague as well as Sharm-el-Sheikh are the most requested destinations for these two long, spring weekends.

The network of direct, scheduled flights\* at Naples International Airport for the spring summer season includes *32 scheduled international routes*, *15 domestic routes and over 50 charter routes*. During the summer season, 27 airlines will be operating from Naples airport.
