**Traffic Forecasts for the first week-end in August 2007**

***Nearly 70,000 passengers for the first week-end in August  
(from Friday 3 August to Sunday 5 August)***

***Good results for passenger traffic recorded during the month of July:  
12% increase over the figures for July 2006***

**During the first week-end in August – from today to Sunday – forecasts call for nearly 70,000 passengers at Naples Airport: 26,000 on domestic flights and 44,000 on international flights.**

**The results of recorded passenger traffic for the month of July were good with 603,000 passengers representing a 12% increase in traffic as opposed to the same period last year.**

**The most popular destinations from Naples for the Summer of 2007 are: Spain (*Barcelona and Madrid* for scheduled flights and *Ibiza and Palma de Mallorca* for both scheduled and charter flights), European capitals (*London, Paris, Dublin, Prague and Budapest*) and charter flights for the Red Sea (*Sharm el Sheikh*), Tunisia (*Monastir*) and *Crete and Rhodes* in Greece.**

***Barcelona and Madrid* for scheduled flights and *Ibiza and Palma* for both scheduled and charter flights) and charter flights for the Mediterranean: Greece (Crete and Rhodes), the Red Sea (*Sharm el Sheik*) and Tunisia (*Monastir*).**
