

**Some 60,000 passengers to travel for New Year 2008**  
**(29 December 2007 to 2 January 2008)**

Between 29 December 2007 and 2 January 2008, forecasts call for some 60,000 passengers to travel through the Naples Airport.

Once again, the European capitals top the list of **international destinations for New Year 2008**:

<b>London</b>	<b>Paris</b>
<b>Madrid</b>	<b>Barcelona</b>
<b>Prague</b>	<b>Vienna</b>

**Between 29 December 2007 and 6 January 2008 – from New Year to the Epiphany – forecasts call for some 115,000 passengers:** with 65,000 on domestic routes, 40,000 on international flights and 10,000 on charter flights. **(a 13% increase has been recorded over the figures for the 2006/2007 holiday period).**

**On the average, traffic figures** will be in the area of **11,000 passengers per day**. The day with heaviest traffic is expected to be **Tuesday 2 January with nearly 14,000 passengers**.

**The Naples International Airport's network of direct flights** was significantly increased for the 2007 spring-summer season and now include some **37 international, scheduled destinations, 14 domestic routes and over 50 charter destinations**. There was a **15% increase in International traffic figures for 2007 as opposed to the figures for 2006**.

**The closing forecast for 2007 is extremely positive: some 5.8 million passengers and a 13% increase over the preceding year.**
