

**NEW DIRECT, SCHEDULED NAPLES-MOSCOW FLIGHT PRESENTED
NAPLES-NEW YORK SERVICE RESUMES AND EXTENDS OPERATIONS
FROM THREE TO SIX MONTHS**

Today, 14 February 2006, the President of the Campania Regional Council, **Antonio Bassolino**, the Regional Transport Councilman, **Ennio Cascetta**, the Regional Tourism Councilman, **Marco Di Lello**, the City of Naples Tourism Councilman, **Luca Esposito**, the Chief Commercial Officer of Eurofly, **Armando Brunini** and the Managing Director and CEO of Gesac Spa, **Mauro Pollio**, presented:

- The first scheduled, direct flight between Naples (Capodichino airport) and Moscow (Domodedovo Airport);
- Resumption and extension (from 3 to 6 months of operations) for the Naples – New York (J. F. Kennedy Airport) route.

1. THE NEW NAPLES-MOSCOW FLIGHT

Two weekly flights beginning 29 April and four flights as of 6 May

The Naples-Moscow flight will initially operate (from 29 April to 6 May) with two flights (departure from Naples on Saturday morning and departure from Moscow on Saturday afternoon). From 6 May until 28 October 2006, the number of flights will double with an additional departure from Naples on Saturday evening and the return flight from Moscow on Sunday morning.

Competitive Fares

The details of the timetable and rates have not as yet been established; especially in reference to the rates which will be competitive as compared to those others on the market.

180-seat aircraft for a four-hour flight

A 180-seat Airbus A320 will be used for the new route.

The flight will last approximately 4 hours and there is a time difference between the two cities, with Moscow two hours ahead.

Forecasts call for traffic primarily comprised of Russian tourists

The new twice-weekly service will mostly serve a demand on the part of Russian tourists but will also meet the needs of Campania area residents who want to reach Eastern Europe.

Specifically, Eurofly in the process of negotiating connections to other important tourist attractions, such as Saint Petersburg, with the largest domestic Russian airlines.

Second scheduled flight from Capodichino for Eastern Europe

This is the second scheduled flight from the Capodichino airport for an in Eastern European Country. The first was Naples-Bucharest.

Co-marketing Initiatives

During 2006, Campania Regional Department of Tourism is planning a series of co-marketing initiatives, similar to those proposed for the Naples-Madrid and the Naples-New York flights, together with Eurofly related to the start-up of the new airline the first step of which will be a billboard campaign in Campania and Russia.

The Campania Regional Council is investing in an international marketing circuit of seven countries including Russia.

The new route will be presented at the Moscow Fair in March.

2. RESUMPTION AND ENHANCEMENT OF THE NAPLES-NEW YORK ROUTE

Six months of operations starting 11 May

Encouraged by last year's success (17,200 passengers in three months of service), Eurofly has prolonged the period of operations for the Naples-New York route from 3 to 6 months.

Service will be operative from 11 May to 11 November on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday with return flights from New York on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

The flights will be serviced with a new, 282-seat Airbus A330

Once again this year, the flights will be operated with an Airbus A330 with 26 business class seats and 256 economy class seat for a total of 282 seats.

On-board Comfort

Great attention has been paid to on-board comfort, and this year will allow passengers to relax or work: each seat will be equipped with in-seat videos, satellite telephones and self-regulating backrests. A new, easy to use system of on-board entertainment will also be available to view films, listen to good music and test your playing skills with a vast selection of videogames. In order to make the flight even more enjoyable and relaxing, Eurofly is currently examining an innovative, new catering service which will certainly satisfy the

tastes of Italian passengers, who are exacting and particularly attentive to gastronomic aspects.

The Promotional Campaign

A promotional campaign in both the USA and Campania has been set up for the resumption of Naples-New York service.

Tickets for both Naples-Moscow and Naples New York service can be purchased through national and international travel agency circuits, by telephoning the Eurofly call centre (199.509.960), or via Internet at www.eurofly.it.

Plans for new flights to various cities in the UK

Lastly, in completing the range of flight activities, Eurofly has announced an agreement with Newmarket Holidays, an English tour operator, for connections to Naples from various airports in the UK including London Stansted, Aberdeen, Glasgow, Humberside, Cardiff, Blackpool, Manston, Bournemouth, Newcastle, Edinburgh, Norwich and Exeter. Service will be in operation every Friday from early May until early July and from mid September to late October.
