PASSENGER TRAFFIC FORECASTS FOR THE EASTER WEEKEND (14-18 April 2006)

During the long Easter weekend, from 14 to 18 April, an estimated 70,000 passengers are expected to depart from or arrive at the Naples airport: 40,000 on domestic routes, 23,000 on scheduled international flights and 7,000 on charter flights.

The heaviest volume of traffic is expected to take place today, Friday 14 April.

The most popular holiday destinations for this Easter weekend are London, Paris, Madrid, Barcelona, Dublin, Budapest, with direct service which was inaugurated today, and Prague, Central Europe's most romantic destination with flights inaugurated yesterday.

Among this year's most important events is the extended period of operations for the Naples – New York intercontinental service which has doubled from 3 to 6 months, new service to Moscow, Oslo and twice-weekly service to Prague, Budapest and Krakow.

For the 2006 Spring-Summer season, the Naples Airport has enhanced its network of routes by offering scheduled, direct service to 27 international destinations, 13 domestic destinations and over 50 charter flights.

For passengers and tourists at the airport over the Easter long weekend, a new facility is now available in the airport departures lounge: the "Oro di Napoli" wine bar aimed at satisfying even the most demanding tastes with samplings of typical local cuisine combined with local wines based upon the finest culinary-oenological Campania traditions.
