

Christmas holidays:
traffic forecast for the period between New Year and the
Epiphany

Roughly 57,000 passengers are expected to travel through the Naples airport over the New Year's weekend – from today to January 2, 2007: 33,000 on domestic flights, 20,000 on international flights and 4,000 on charter flights.

For the Epiphany – between 5-7 January 2007, forecasts call for nearly 33,000 passengers with 19,000 on domestic flights, 12,000 on international flights and 2,000 on charter flights.

The following are the most requested international destinations for the 2006 holidays:

Overall, – during the holiday period – between 22 December and 7 January, 2007 a total of approximately **180,000 passengers** will be travelling through the Naples airport: **114,000 on domestic flights, 60,000 on international flights and 6,000 on charter flights.**

On the average, the daily flow should be roughly **11,000 passengers** and the highest flow is expected to take place on **Tuesday, 2 January** with nearly **14,000 passengers.**

Naples International Airport expects to close out 2006 with excellent results: nearly 5.1 million passengers and a 10.4% increase in traffic over 2005. On 21 December, a celebration was held for this year's **5 millionth passenger**, 27-year-old Giovanna Giardinelli, who was travelling to Prague with a group of friends.

More specifically, the figures for scheduled international traffic in 2006 are extremely positive with a 16% increase over the figures for last year, which is due to the results obtained in increasing international scheduled traffic by enhancing the network of connections and establishing new routes.

The network of direct connections from Naples International Airport was significantly increased during 2006 and now boasts **29 scheduled international destinations, 13 domestic destinations and over 50 charter flight destinations.**
