

FORECASTED TRAFFIC DATA FOR AUGUST 2005

This summer between 5 and 21 August, approximately 285,000 passengers will be arriving or departing from the Naples airport: 105,000 on domestic flights, 95,000 on international flights and 85,000 on charter flights.

The peak day, with the greatest volume of traffic, is expected to be **19 August with almost 23,000 passengers**.

The primary destinations for Summer 2005 are: New York – with the new intercontinental direct flight inaugurated last 14 June, - Barcelona, London and Paris while the traditional Mediterranean destinations, such as Greece (Crete, Mykonos, Rhodes, Santorini) Spain (Ibiza and Palma de Majorca) and Tunisia (Djerba and Monastir) are the preferred destinations for charter flights from Naples.

Additionally, in reference to charter traffic, recent international events which have struck **Sharm El Sheikh** have resulted in a reduction in the number of flights and transported passengers to tourist destinations on the Red Sea.

During the month of July, the Naples airport served roughly **495,000 passengers, (a 1,8% increase over July 2004)** which confirms **growth in international traffic with a recorded increase of 11% and nearly 167,000 passengers**.
