### Air traffic forecast for 6 to 22 August, 2010

**345,000 passengers expected between Friday, 6 August and Sunday, 22 August.**

Between 6 and 22 August, some 342,000 passengers will depart from or arrive at Naples Airport: 115,000 on domestic flights, 150,000 on international flights and 80,000 on charter flights.

The day with the greatest forecasted traffic flow will be **21 August with some 26,000 passengers.**

The main destinations for Summer 2010 are the scheduled international flights for *New York, London, Paris, Barcelona, Berlin, Dublin, Amsterdam and Copenhagen* while the most requested tourist destinations via charter service from Naples are, once again, the Mediterranean destinations of *Mykonos and Rhodes (Greece) Ibiza and Palma de Mallorca (Spain) Djerba and Monastir (Tunisia)* and the Red Sea sites of *Sharm El Sheikh and Marsa Alam.*

During the month of July, the following scheduled, direct flights were launched: **easyjet for Ibiza (11 July)**, direct service for **Nice operated by Airitaly (26 July)** as well as a new **Spanair flight for Barcelona (27 July)** and the **Sevenair flight between Naples- Tunis (3 August).**

**During the month of July, Naples airport recorded traffic of some 600,000 passengers and a 6.2% increase over the figures for July of the previous year.**

The Naples International Airport network of direct flights for this summer is composed of **31 scheduled international routes, 13 direct domestic routes for a total of 44 direct, scheduled flights** \*.
