WIND JET: SUMMER 2009 IN NAPLES

Naples, 5 *March*, 2009- As of 29 March, 2009 new service, operated by Wind Jet, between Naples and Forli will be operative. Flights will operate from Monday to Saturday on Airbus 320s and 319s with, respectively, seating capacity for 180 and 140 passengers.

For the launch of this new service, Wind Jet is now offering promotional, all-inclusive fares of 15.32.

Wind Jet has recently been classified by Airline Business, the world's leading aviation magazine, as Italy's foremost low-cost carrier.

In 2008, the Sicilian company carried some 2,750,000 passengers and, in 2009, expects to carry more than 3,000,000 (representing a 9% increase over the figures for the preceding year).

For the 2009 Summer season, Wind Jet will offer service to new domestic destinations (from Forlì to Naples, Cagliari and Lampedusa) as well as new international destinations (from Catania and Palermo to Nantes and Lyon, from Forlì to Amsterdam, Berlin, Krakow, Brussels, Timisoara, Riga, Paris, Prague). These flights are in addition to the already operative flights from Forlì to Bucharest, St. Petersburg, Moscow and Samara.

Wind Jet, Italy's leading low-cost airline *, was established in June, 2003 with the objective of providing service between Sicily and the most important cities in Italy and Europe. The airline is based upon the low-cost model. Wind Jet initially consolidated its domestic network and subsequently aimed at establishing service to and from the most important European destinations.

Wind Jet's network includes the following destinations: in Italy: Catania, Palermo, Forlì, Milan (Linate), Venice, Cagliari, Verona, Rome Fiumicino, Pisa, Naples, Lampedusa, Turin and Parma; in Europe: Brussels, Amsterdam, Paris, Barcelona, Moscow, St. Petersburg, Samara, Bucharest, Nantes, Lyon, Krakow, Timisoara, Riga, Prague and Berlin. Additionally, Wind Jet, in partnership with the most renown Italian tour operators, also operates charter flights to European capitals and resort areas in Egypt, Spain, the Canary Islands, the Balearic Islands, Turkey, Greece. Morocco and Tunisia. Wind Jet also operates annual charter flights from Rome and Catania to Israel. All flights are operated on 180- seat Airbus 320sand 142-seat Airbus 319s.

The Wind Jet fleet receives technical support, provision of components and spare part management from Lufthansa Technik, the world's leading provider of aviation maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO). Wind Jet's technical sector is certified to carry out all light maintenance operations (Certificate JAR 145).
