TRAFFIC FORECASTS FOR THE EASTER HOLIDAYS **(Friday 10 – Tuesday 14 April, 2009)**

During the long Easter weekend*, 10 - 14 April, an estimated **75,000 passengers will be arriving or departing from Naples airport**: *40 thousand on domestic routes, 28 thousand on international routes and 7 thousand on charter flights.*

The most popular international destinations for this Easter weekend continue to be the main European destinations such as: **London, Paris, Madrid, Barcelona, Prague** and **Vienna**, as well as tourist resorts on the **Red Sea**.

The 2009 Naples International Airport spring-summer network of flights includes: **27 international scheduled destinations and 15 direct domestic flights (see attached chart outlining the most important additions to the 2009 spring-summer network)**.
. During the 2009 summer season, there will be 27 airlines operating from Naples airport.

* **Note:** *A comparison with the data from last year is not possible owing to the fact that Easter 2008 fell in the month of March (winter season) whereas, in 2009, Easter takes place in the month of April (the start of the summer season).*

Summary of main traffic data:

During the first quarter (January, February and March) of 2009, the negative trend in passenger traffic at Naples airport continued with a **16,5%** decline as compared to the figures for the first quarter in 2008. In particular, during the month of March, recorded passenger traffic was **14%** less than the same period in 2008.

Naples airport closed out 2008 with 5,643,000 passengers and, for the first time in many years, recorded an annual decrease in traffic amounting to 2.3% less than in 2007.
