From 30 April to 4 May - for the Labour Day weekend - some 80,000 passengers are expected to use Naples Airport

From tomorrow, 30 April, until Monday, 4 May, for the Labour Day weekend, a total of 80,000 passengers are expected to arrive at or depart from the airport: **40 thousand on domestic flights, 30 thousand on international flights and 10 thousand on charter flights.**

The greatest volume of passenger traffic is expected to take place **Monday 4 May** with some **18,000 passengers.**

Barcelona, London, Paris, Madrid, Dublin and Prague, as well as **Sharm-el-Sheikh** are the **top destinations for the Labour Day weekend.**

The Naples International Airport's Spring-Summer network of direct flights includes: **28 scheduled, direct international flights, 15 direct national routes and over 50 charter destinations.** During the summer season, 27 airlines will be operating from Naples airport.
