

2000 end-of-year results confirm the Naples International Airport's positive growth trend: Southern Italy's number one airport in terms of passenger volume.

Over 4.1 million passengers and a sharp increase in International scheduled flights: +26% over 1999.

The year 2000 ended on an extremely positive note for the Naples International Airport which was confirmed as the number one airport in southern Italy in terms of passenger volume. Over the course of the year, more than 4 million travellers used the airport representing a 13% increase over 1999.

During the year there was an increase in both domestic and international service with new connections for Milan Linate for a total of 6 daily flights, Cagliari, Catania, Palermo, Parma and Verona. The increase over 1999 in international traffic (+26%) is of particular note and is due to new flights to Amsterdam and Barcelona and increased service to London, Nice and Paris each with three daily flights.

The Naples airport offers scheduled flights to 10 domestic and 11 international destinations including the principal capitals of Europe (Barcelona, Brussels, London, Paris) and over 50 charter destinations. Domestic traffic represents 65% of all traffic, international flights 17% and charter flights 18%.

The all time record for number of passengers served per month was recorded during the month of September with 452,208 passengers. On the 23rd of the same month, the record for number of passengers per day was recorded with 22,077 passengers.

In order to meet the growing demands of increased passenger traffic, Gesac has developed a long-term investment plan which has provided for increases in the number of check-in counters, parking places and stands which have signified overall improvement in the services offered by the airport. Currently, 25 billion Italian lire have been spent on infrastructure works which will allow for further improvements in airport comfort and security, enlargement of the arrivals and departures areas, a new airport access road and cargo terminal.
