

## **Security measures incremented at Naples airport following terrorist attacks in the United States**

- No shipments of US-bound cargo or mail until 48 hours following the opening of US air space
- Heightened cross reference checks of passenger identification and boarding passes
- X-ray scanning of all US-bound checked baggage
- Access to customs area restricted to authorized personnel
- Heightened surveillance and controls on the part of Polaria (airport police) and local Military Airport Command within their respective areas of competence

The above-cited measures were prescribed by the Ministry of the Interior Department of Police Forces and received by ENAC (National Civil Aviation Agency) and, on a local level, by the Security Board comprised of local authorities and the airport operators.

At the Naples airport, the road adjacent to the terminal has been closed and inspection and surveillance procedures have been intensified throughout the entire airport area.

The airport operator has reinforced operating personnel in order to guarantee passengers all required assistance and the full efficiency of all airport operations.

Gesac also advises departing passengers to carry valid identification (identity card or passport), to arrive at the airport allowing ample time for check in and security procedures and to use the Viale Maddalena entrance.
