

At 10:00 a.m. tomorrow, the 81st School District of San Pietro a Paterno will present "Musical Knowledge Day" a project which has been carried out thanks to the contribution of the Naples International Airport.

"Musical Knowledge Day" is a year-end recital for those children of the 81st School District who, during the year, have participated in special musical theory, chorus and instrumental laboratories.

The project, developed in conjunction with Gesac BAA, involved a total of 800 children between the ages of 3 and 11 in the pre-school and elementary levels of three schools, "Cacciottoli", "San Francesco" e "Selva Cafaro" of the 81st District.

The programme includes choral performances and musical executions on the guitar, electric keyboard and orff instruments – small percussion instruments – performed by very young, true talents who transport the audience back to a childhood world which adults often forget was once an important part of their lives and remind us that *"love is the only motor of that airplane within our hearts that requires an expert aviator for a painless landing"*.

The 81st School District is one of the schools in the area "adopted" by the Naples International Airport which has, for years, promoted and given support to projects involving local communities.

"With the support of the Airport, the 81st School District, has been able to plan and carry out projects related to instruction, training and special education which encourage the right to education and promote the potential, individuality and interior wealth of each of these children and, particularly in light of the operational context, assure the success of the educational process"– stated Vittoria Serritelli, School Principal of the 81st School District.
