Agreement reached between Gesac and local health authorities (Naples ASL 1) for the airport health services and emergency medical assistance plan

Today an agreement was signed by the ASL 1 General Director, Professor Angelo Montemarano and Gesac Managing Director Mauro Pollio, Engineer, for the airport health services and emergency health plan.

The agreement guarantees 24 hour a day, 365 days a year medical assistance to be provided by ASL NA 1 personnel, with the support of avant-garde equipment, for passengers and employees as well as emergency transport, if needed, to local hospital centres. Specifically, three physicians, two trained nurses and two drivers are to be on duty at all times, and three state-of-the-art ambulances connected to the 118 emergency system and material and equipment for will be available for handling critical situations (accidents involving infrastructure and/or aircraft).

The agreement also calls for the creation of an ASL NA 1 first aid station to be located in the arrivals concourse, open 24 hours a day and connected with the 118 emergency network, as well as fully equipped medical station to be located near the control tower for assistance in the event of a serious emergency.
