Traffic forecast from 5 to 21 August, 2011

All time record number of passengers on scheduled (domestic and international) flights recorded during the month of July at Naples airport

From Friday, 5 August to Sunday 21 August, some 360 thousand passengers are expected to arrive or depart from Naples airport: *120,000 on domestic flights, 180,000 on international flights and 80,000 on charter flights.*

The day with the greatest expected passenger flow will be **Saturday, 20 August with some 28,000 passengers.**

The most requested destinations for Summer 2011 are: *New York* - the intercontinental Meridianafly flight with operations scheduled twice a week (Wednesday and Friday), the easyjet daily scheduled flight for *Ibiza*, the new direct flight operated by **Turkish Airlines for **Istanbul**, inaugurated 28 June, and scheduled international routes bound for **London, Paris, Barcelona and Madrid.****

The most popular tourist charter destinations from Naples are *Ibiza and Palma de Majorca* in Spain, Crete, Mykonos, Rhodes and the Santorini islands in Greece and *Bodrum and Antalya* in Turkey.

During the month of July, Naples airport hit an all time record for the number of passengers on scheduled domestic and international flights with some 529,000 passengers*.

Currently, the Summer 2011 network at Naples International Airport provides service to 41 destinations: 29 international, 12 domestic and over 50 charter destinations operated by the most important Italian and foreign airlines.

During the first seven months of 2011, from January to July, some 3,240,000 passengers utilised Naples airport (+4,6% as compared to the first seven months of 2010) and, in particular, a 14% increase over the figures for the same period last year was recorded in international scheduled traffic.

** Record number of passengers on scheduled domestic and international flights; the previous record high was recorded in September of 2007.*
