United Airlines to Increase Nonstop Seasonal Flights between Naples and New York/Newark to twice daily

United is the only airline to serve North America from Naples

NAPLES, 24 February 2023 - United Airlines has announced an increase in its seasonal service between Naples and New York/Newark for 2023 with a doubling of flights from once to twice daily during the summer peak. United's seasonal service from Naples is set to operate from 6 May - 28 October 2023, increasing from once to twice daily during the summer peak (23 June - 7 September 2023).

The additional seasonal service from Naples joins United's existing year-round daily services from Milan and Rome to New York/Newark, seasonal daily services from Rome to Chicago and Washington Dulles, from Milan to Chicago and from Venice to New York/Newark, as well as a new daily seasonal service between Rome and San Francisco, set to start on 26 May 2023. United flies from more cities in Italy to the United States than any other airline and will offer up to 10 daily nonstop services from Italy to the U.S. during the summer season 2023.

"We are excited to return to Naples for summer 2023 and announce an additional daily flight, as we further expand our route network between Italy and the U.S.," said Walter Cianciusi, United Country Sales Manager Italy. "We expect another busy summer for international travel in 2023 and are delighted to be able to offer our customers in southern Italy even greater travel choice with the possibility to connect via our New York/Newark hub to over 90 destinations across the Americas."

"The doubling of the daily flight to New York is a concrete signal of the excellent response to this route," said Roberto Barbieri, CEO of Gesac. "But it is also and above all, the result of a partnership with an excellent operator, such as United Airlines that has been able to grasp the enormous potential of the Campania region. The increase in frequencies translates into a substantial development of connectivity for the Neapolitan airport that, through fast and convenient connections from United's New York/Newark hub, will allow passengers to continue to many destinations in the United States, Canada, the Caribbean and Latin America. Once again, Naples airport plays a crucial and driving role in the development of the economic sector related to tourism and transport."
