Between 1 and 4 November - for the long All Saints Day weekend – forecasts call for some 55,000 passengers in arrival and departure

From Thursday, 1 November to Sunday, 4 November some 55,000 passengers are expected to use the Naples Airport: 31,000 on domestic flights, 21,000 on international flights and 3,000 on charter flights.

The heaviest traffic is expected to occur on **Saturday, 3 November** with some **15,000** passengers.

Once again, the most requested international destinations are European capitals, specifically Barcelona, Madrid, Budapest, Prague and Vienna. The number of flights to Vienna has been increased, as of 28 October, in addition to the flight operated by Air One, there is a new flight (four times a week) operated by SkyEurope, a low cost airline.

Naples International Airport's flight network has significantly expanded during 2007 and now counts **37 international destinations, 14 domestic flights and over 50 charter flight destinations.**

During the first nine months of 2007 (January-September) some 4,452,000 passengers used the Naples Airport amounting to a 13% increase over the first nine months of 2006. Specifically, domestic traffic grew 15% while international traffic grew 16% as opposed to the same period in 2006.
