

PRESS NOTE

From today, 29 October, until Tuesday 2 November – for the All Saints Day long weekend – some *75,000 passengers are expected.*

From today, 29 October, until Tuesday, 2 November, some 75,000 passengers are expected to utilise Naples Airport: *40,000 on domestic routes, 28,000 on international flights and 7,000 on charter service.*

***London, Madrid, Prague and Berlin* are the most requested international scheduled destinations for the long All Saints Day weekend.**

Additionally, as of Sunday 31 October, the winter time table with the new network* of direct domestic and international flights will become effective (until 26 March, 2011).

***Winter Network of Domestic and International Destinations:**

- **11 domestic destinations: *Bologna, Cagliari, Catania, Genoa, Milan, Palermo, Rome, Turin, Trieste, Venice and Verona;***
- **18 international destinations: *Amsterdam, Athens, Barcelona, Basel, Berlin, Brussels, Bucharest, Budapest, Cologne, Frankfurt, Geneva, London, Madrid, Munich, Paris, Prague, Stuttgart, Tunis;***
