Traffic forecast for 7-23 August, 2009

330,000 passengers expected to arrive and depart between Friday 7 and Sunday 23 August

During the month of July, a total of 562,000 passengers was recorded (4.1% less than July, 2008)

From Friday, 7 August until Sunday, 23 August, some 330,000 passengers will be arriving and departing from Naples airport: 120,000 on domestic flights, 135,000 on international flights and 75,000 on charter flights.

The day with the highest forecasted flow of traffic is **21 August with some 23,000 passengers.**

The main destinations for Summer, 2009 are, as regards scheduled international flights, London, Paris, Barcelona, Madrid, Prague and Budapest as well as the intercontinental flight for New York while, as regards charter service from Naples, the favourite tourist destinations are in the Mediterranean and include Crete, Mykonos, Rhodes and the Santorini Islands in Greece; Ibiza and Palma Mallorca in Spain; Djerba and Monastir in Tunisia and the Red Sea resort of Sharm El Sheikh.

During the month of July, Naples airport recorded some 562,000 passengers which represents a 4.1% decline in traffic as opposed to July of the previous year.

Currently, the network* includes 28 international destinations, 14 domestic destinations and over 50 charter destinations. During this summer season, 27 airlines are operating from Naples airport.
