For the long week-end of 2 June, some 90,000 passengers, in arrival or departure, are expected

From 29 May to 2 June, during the long Republic Day week-end, forecasts for Naples airport call for some 90,000 passengers in arrival or departure*: 45,000 on domestic flights, 35,000 on international flights and 10,000 on charter flights.

The day in which the largest passenger traffic flow is expected is **today Friday, 29 May** with some **23,000** passengers.

The most popular international destinations are London, Paris, Madrid, Dublin and Barcelona, as well as **Sharm-el-Sheikh (charter)**.

Naples International Airport's network of direct flights for the 2009 spring-summer season includes **direct service from Naples to and from 43 destinations: scheduled, international service to 28 destinations and direct flights for 15 domestic destinations**. This summer, **27 airlines** will operate from Naples airport.

**As opposed to the same period in 2008, a 5% decline in traffic forecasts has been recorded.*
