

AlpiEagles launches scheduled Naples-Madrid service and further strengthens its Naples network

As of tomorrow, 3 November, AlpiEagles will offer international service to Madrid, a first for this route, to operate on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

The flights - operating last generation, 94-seat (82 economy and 12 business class) Jet Fokker 100s - are scheduled at the following times:

To launch the new flight, AlpiEagles is offering the following introductory round trip rates on this route valid until 19 December 2001: IT£ 299,000 (taxes excluded).

AlpiEagles has further enhanced its Naples network by offering a third daily flight on its Naples Catania and Naples-Palermo routes and a fourth daily flight for Venice.

AlpiEagles originated as an acrobatic squadron in 1982 and has since evolved into a public service airline. Today, AlpiEagles has become an international airline whose primary objective is focused on maximum client satisfaction.

The Venetian airlines, in operation from Naples since 1999, has heavily invested in the Naples airport with scheduled flights for Barcelona, Catania, Palermo, Paris and Venice.
