

Naples – Amsterdam: a new direct scheduled flight operated by the Dutch airlines Transavia

At the start of the new spring-summer season, a new connection will be serving the Naples-Amsterdam route, departing three times a week and operated by the Dutch airlines Transavia.

The inaugural flight, which took place 1 April at the Naples International Airport before a crowded Dutch delegation made up of members of the press and representatives of the principal tour operator groups, was presided by the Mayor's Advisor for Tourism of the City of Naples Giulia Parente.

The timetable for the new flights, operated with 149-seat, Boeing 737s, is as follows:
