



WIZZ AIR ANNOUNCES A MAJOR EXPANSIONS IN CAMPANIA

- **Three new routes to Brasov, Chisinau and Tel Aviv from Naples; the Sharm el-Sheikh route becomes year-round**
- **An additional aircraft, over 50 new direct jobs, and 45 weekly flights from Campania**

Naples, April 16, 2025 – **Wizz Air**, the most eco-friendly airline in the EMEA region, **announced today a further expansion of its network from Campania with three new routes, supported by the addition of a brand-new Airbus A321neo aircraft at the Naples base for the winter season 2025.**

The new routes will connect the Campania main city to three exciting destinations. Wizz Air will operate flights **from Naples to Braşov (Romania) and Tel Aviv (Israel) with three weekly frequencies, and to Chisinau (Moldova) with four weekly flights.** Additionally, the company will make the **Sharm el-Sheikh (Egypt) route operational all year round, including the summer season.** Tickets are already available on the official Wizz Air website and app, starting from just **€24.99.**

The second Airbus A321neo will be based in Naples starting October 2025, allowing Wizz Air to operate a total of 11 routes from the regional capital of Campania. The airline will also continue flights to Bucharest and Tirana from Salerno, **for a total of 13 routes to 8 countries from Campania,** increasing low-cost travel options in the region. Thanks to unique connections with Braşov and Chisinau, Wizz Air will further strengthen regional connectivity between Italy, Romania, and Moldova, fostering closer ties between Italy and these dynamic Eastern European markets.

This development will bring Wizz Air's weekly flights from Naples and Salerno to 45, further consolidating the airline's presence in the region and across Italy. Besides offering more travel options, **Wizz Air's growth in Naples will create over 50 new direct jobs within the company and contribute to the creation of more than 300 local jobs in related sectors,** boosting the regional economy.

Currently, Wizz Air operates a network of over 200 low-cost routes in Italy, connecting passengers to 31 countries from 24 Italian airports. Since starting operations, the airline has transported nearly 100 million passengers to and from Italian airports. In 2024, it operated nearly 92,000 flights to and from Italy, with a 99.5% on-time performance rate, one of the best in the industry.

This expansion is **part of Wizz Air's broader growth strategy, supported by a modern, fuel-efficient fleet and the "Customer First Compass" initiative, a €14 billion investment over the next three years** aimed at improving service, reliability, and innovation.

During the press conference in Naples, **Salvatore Gabriele Imperiale, Wizz Air's Corporate Communications Manager, said:** "We are excited to expand our offerings from Campania by introducing three new routes from Naples and making our Sharm el-Sheikh route year-round. We continue to provide travellers with direct and convenient access to destinations across Europe and beyond, allowing them to explore new places and enjoy unique experiences. Italy remains a key market for Wizz Air. With these new routes and the addition of an Airbus A321neo at our Naples base, we will operate 45 weekly flights to and from Campania, offering even more affordable travel options and creating new jobs. We look forward to welcoming Neapolitan passengers onboard and supporting regional connectivity and economic growth in Campania."

Margherita Chiamonte, Commercial Director of Aviation, commented: "We are very pleased that the Campanian airport system continues to attract carriers and new investments, making our region easily accessible from an increasing number of airports across Europe and around the world. This significant investment, which includes the positioning of a second aircraft based in Naples and three additional



routes, two of which are new to the Naples airport, confirms the strength of our collaboration and the central role of Campania in the company's growth strategies. We are also particularly pleased that Wizz Air operates with environmentally friendly aircraft, fully aligned with GESAC's sustainable development strategy, which has led the Naples airport to achieve Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA) level 5, the highest environmental recognition in the airport sector. This is a national first, making us the first airport in Italy to reach this milestone and the tenth airport management company in the world."
