easyJet announces the arrival in Salerno, the first flight on July 11

- easyJet announces the start of operations to and from Salerno - Costa d'Amalfi airport, further strengthening its presence in Campania region.
- Milan Malpensa, London Gatwick, Berlin, Basel and Geneva the destinations reachable from Salerno, for sale today on easyJet channels.

With five new routes, easyJet announces and confirms the start of operations from the airport of Salerno – Costa d'Amalfi starting next July 11, scheduled date of opening of the airport. The first to land will be the flight from Milan Malpensa, followed by flights from Basel, Geneva and Berlin on 12 July. The long-awaited flight from London Gatwick will land on 13 July.

The announcement was made by Johan Lundgren, CEO of easyJet, on the occasion on a visit to Naples, together with the Roberto Barbieri, CEO of Gesac.

The new connections will be initially operated during the summer season with three weekly frequencies for the route Milan Malpensa - Salerno and two weekly frequencies for London Gatwick, Basel, Geneva and Berlin. Flights are on sale today, February 29, on easyJet.com, the mobile app and GDS channels.

With the addition of these five new routes departing from Salerno, the total capacity offered by easyJet in Campania in the next summer season rises to almost three million places, with 51 routes to 13 countries. easyJet has recently also announced that next summer it will base the additional, eighth aircraft at its base at Naples International Airport, introducing some new destinations including Nantes in France, Sitia (Crete), Preveza (Lefkada) and the island of Zakynthos, Greece.

From next July, with the start of operations from the airport of Salerno - Costa d'Amalfi, 23 will be the airports in Italy on which easyJet will operate this summer.

Next summer, the offer of tourist packages by easyJet Holidays also increases, the tour operator of the Group that every year transports thousands of tourists from the United Kingdom (and recently also from Switzerland, Germany and France) to the most iconic destinations of Southern Italy too, through partnerships with local accommodation and taking advantage of the wide range of flights guaranteed by the easyJet network. This year over 700 Italian hotels will be to be part of the offer of easyJet Holidays, which already brought thousands of English tourists to Naples last summer

Lorenzo Lagorio, Country Manager easyJet Italia, ha commented:

"We have always believed in Naples and Campania, as evidenced by the new routes, the continuous growth and investments of these years, including the entry into our fleet based in Naples of two Airbus A320 NEO, Next-generation airplanes that have reduced emissions and noise.

Now we are really excited to announce that this summer we will also start operating at the airport of Salerno – Costa d'Amalfi. This step strengthens our historic collaboration with GESAC, lasting from with almost twenty-five years, with the aim of connecting Campania with the main destinations in Italy and Europe, supporting the development of tourism and the economy of the territory".

Roberto Barbieri, CEO GESAC, has commented:

"The announcement of easyJet is the result of intense teamwork aimed at offering a range of destinations that can meet the mobility needs of both citizens and tourists who want to visit an area rich in history and culture. Thanks to the completion of Phase 1 of the Development Plan on the one hand, and the strong relations with the airlines on the other hand, we finally open the second airport in Campania, on time indicated and with a stable, quality and destined to grow offer flights. But the job continues with the Phase 2 of the Development Plan that foresees, among the other investments, the ulterior lengthening of the runway until 2.200 meters and the realization of the new Passenger terminal, previewed in 2026. The new terminal, of about 16 thousand square meters, will reflect the highest environmental standards both in terms of energy efficiency and for the use of natural and sustainable materials, with architectural choices based on respect for the environment, integration with the territory and the connection with the landscape".
