

Naples - May 19, 2025. Airport infrastructures undergo regular and periodic maintenance interventions, both ordinary and extraordinary, in compliance with rigorous industry regulations and in line with the airport management's priority commitment to ensuring the highest safety standards.

As already communicated to the Institutions, in accordance with the 2023-2026 four-year intervention plan, from January 19, 2026 to March 1, 2026, Naples airport's runway will undergo radical renovation works that will require the closure of the airport for 42 days.

The intervention has been scheduled during the period of the year historically characterized by lower air traffic in order to minimize inconvenience for passengers.

Airlines, duly informed, will revise their flight schedules based on their operational and commercial strategies. The Salerno-Costa d'Amalfi airport, operating as part of a regional airport system, will absorb part of the air traffic normally handled by the Naples airport, within the capacity limits established by ENAC and according to the slot requests received.
