### **Air Canada Adds Flights Between Naples and Montreal for Summer 2025**

- *Air Canada will offer more flights from Italy to Canada than any other airline, with 39 weekly frequencies in total from Naples, Rome, Venice and Milan to Canada for summer 2025*
- *Airline increases flights in Italy by seven per cent for summer 2025*

NAPLES, ITALY, 6<sup>th</sup> February 2025 – Air Canada is launching a new route connecting Naples to Montreal for summer 2025, the airline’s fourth destination in Italy in addition to Rome, Milan and Venice. This makes Air Canada the airline that offers the most non-stop flights between Italy and Canada of any airline, with up to 39 weekly services for summer 2025, reflecting a seven per cent increase in flights compared to the previous year.

The presentation today, at the Giunta Hall of the Municipality of Naples, with the Mayor Gaetano Manfredi, the Canadian Ambassador to Italy Elissa Golberg, the Québec Delegate Laurence Fouquette-L’Anglais, the General Manager, Sales & Legal Representative of Air Canada Stefano Casaregola, and the CEO of GESAC Roberto Barbieri.

For summer 2025, customers in Italy can choose from four new weekly flights from Naples to Montreal on a Boeing 787 Dreamliner, up to three daily flights from Rome to Toronto and Montreal, or daily flights from Venice and Milan Malpensa to Toronto and Montreal. In addition to the most connections within Canada, customers can enjoy convenient onward flights to the United States, benefiting from U.S. Customs pre-clearance at both Air Canada’s Toronto and Montreal hubs.

For winter season 2025, Air Canada is the only airline connecting Rome to Canada non-stop, year-round with services to both Toronto and Montreal. These routes complement Air Canada’s existing year-round services from Milan Malpensa to Montreal and onwards to Toronto. All flights offer convenient onward connections via Air Canada’s Canadian hubs to destinations across the Americas, including popular sun destinations, such as Miami, Orlando, Cancun, Punta Cana and San Jose (Costa Rica).

“Today’s news once again underlines the importance of Italy to Air Canada’s global network and we are excited to announce yet another route to Canada for summer 2025,” said Stefano Casaregola, General Manager Sales & Legal Representative in Italy “We are proud to be the airline offering the most non-stop flights between Italy and Canada of any carrier, as well as being the preferred choice for business travel between the main economic hubs of both nations.

This new route reinforces the historical ties and economic relations between the two countries and consolidates the intercontinental segment of Naples airport, which is crucial for the development of tourist flows and commercial exchanges. Campania is one of the most sought-after destinations for Canadian tourists, and Montréal, in addition to being the ideal destination to explore French-speaking Canada, is a multicultural city that hosts a large Italian-Canadian community, which will greatly benefit from the direct connection,” said Roberto Barbieri, CEO of GESAC.

“The launch of a new intercontinental route to Naples is significant from many perspectives. The no-stop connection between Naples and Montréal is a great development opportunity for transportation to and from Capodichino, a central hub for tourist and commercial flows. It is also an important investment for the economic impact this route can have on our city and its people. In a time of great changes for the city and its revival as a Euro-Mediterranean capital, we can only welcome this further point of contact with Canada and the Canadian market, with which we will build increasingly close ties from a tourist, cultural, and commercial perspective,” said Gaetano Manfredi, Mayor of Naples.

From summer 2025, Air Canada’s flights from Naples to Montreal will operate on the airline’s flagship Boeing 787 Dreamliners. Customers in Italy can choose from three classes of service: Economy, Premium Economy, and Air Canada Signature Class, offering customers superior comfort and convenience in an exclusive cabin, with spacious lie-flat seating, personalized service, fine cuisine, extra baggage allowance and access to priority airport services. All flights are timed to optimize connectivity to Air Canada’s extensive North American network.
